- There is also strong linkage between IMAGINATION & PLACE...
 - Fuentes writes out of the experience of living in Mexico, the United States, and Paris.... and of having visited many other regions within the world.....
 - He calls himself "a wanderer in search of a perspective..."
 - But wherever he went, he knew that SPANISH WOULD BE THE LANGUAGE OF HIS WRITING....and LATIN AMERICA THE CULTURE OF MY LANGUAGE.....
 - And it is from within this orientation that he includes all of the others -- the other cities, the other writers he has known, the experiences he has had....

FOUR WRITERS: Baldwin, Berry, Cliff, and Fuentes

Baldwin talks about LIVING WITHIN ILLUSIONS
CREATED BY THE DOMINANT CULTURE....
and having to fight for REALITY

BERRY talks about a time when the culture was whole, and when there was HARMONY between the LAND, the PEOPLE, and the COMMUNITY...

- CLIFF years for WHOLENESS within FRAGMENTATION, and has a gift for describing the RRAGMENTATION...
 - and FUENTES explores the sense of PLACE upon one's understanding of personal identity
- Together, they provide powerful TESTIMONY on the the MEANING OF MULTI-CULTURE....
 - In fact, in at least three of these instances (BALDWIN, CLIFF, and FUENTES), we have probings of what is meant by MULTI-CULTURAL LITERACY
 - that is, about how one becomes LITERATE in a Multi-Cultural Context...
- And the point is that it isn't simply a matter of learning about other people... or about people who are different from oneself...
 - It's also a matter of learning how to speak, write, think, and consider oneself in relationship to the multi-versity in which one's life is cast....
- At bottom, the VOICE OF THE STRANGER is one's own VOICE... but a VOICE that needs to be discovered within the diverse culture within which one lives...

WENDELL BERRY --

A Kentucky farmer, poet, writer....

His point: the people are connected to the land....and find their identity in this connection....

history of the land....(retell it)
but when the gas-powered Tractor enters the scene...
everything changes.... (breaks the harmony)

things become MEANS OF PRODUCTION

WHEN THINGS ARE IN ORDER...

that is, when people are joined to the land, THERE IS WORK.... LAND, WORK, PEOPLE, and COMMUNITY are all tied together....

Berry says: we judge intelligence not by the ability to recite facts, but by the GOOD ORDER or HARMONIOUSNESS of a person's surroundings....

BERRY'S PLEA: Take Care of the Land, for the LAND SUSTAINS US...

Michelle Cliff -- a black woman writer...

talks about the challenge a writer faces:
She lives in a community that has been COLONIALIZED....

She doesn't wish only to criticize the dominant society...
And she doesn't wish simply to write about trivial matters...

BUT HOW DOES ONE FIND WHOLENESS FROM FRAGMENTATION...WHILE FRAGMENTATION IS THE PRIMARY REALITY.

That is, WHERE DOES ONE FIND WHOLENESS WITHIN FRAGMENTATION?

Cliff's subject: to describe what it is like to be the COLONIZED... that is, to live under subjection to the COLONIZERS...

A second CLIFF piece is called, "IF I COULD WRITE THIS IN FIRE,"
I WOULD WRITE THIS IN FIRE."

this is an <u>autobiographical</u> piece -- very powerful piece...

Carlos FUENTES...

tells us of the process by which he became a writer
-- talks about bridging several world: MEXICO and UNITED STATES,
to be sure, but FRANCE as well, and other places..
and FUENTES searches to discover himself in all of this...

"ONE ALWAYS WRITES OUT OF A TRADITION," Fuentes declares...
And there is a close linkage between the TRADITION and the IMAGINATION.....

Highlight some of the themes in the reading assignments:

MULTI-CULTURAL LITERACY: note the intention: to develop a book list that is multi-cultural, and not simply Euro-American...

(explain this in more detail)

James Baldwin's TALK TO TEACHERS:

Baldwin insists that the purpose of education is to open students' eyes to the realities that surround him.

He is particularly interested in enabling students to know the REAL STORY of the relationships between WHITES and BLACKS in this country...a subject that he believes is GLOSSED OVER in most schools, and in most classes.

Why is it glossed over -- because the people in charge don't want to upset things... because in their society, the BLACKS are the working class.

THEY CAME AS SLAVES...

AND WHAT DO SLAVES REPRESENT? Answer: a source of cheap labor Slavery was indispensable to the economy...

Baldwin says that this could only happen when <u>blacks</u> were <u>dehumanized</u>...treated and regarded as ANIMALS...

The DOMINANT SOCIETY made money off of BLACK FLESH.

And black children in school can't discover this truth... because the DOMINANT SOCIETY doesn't want to tell it this way...

BUT, if the TRUTH WERE TOLD, Black Americans could be liberated...on the basis of their understanding of their true history...

And WHITES could be liberated too....because they have been FORCED TO TELL LIES....

The LIES are carried on the MYTHS about America....

Hearing the story, people are prepared to believe that the first Americans were like GARY COOPER....the good guys in the WHITE HATS...

But that's really not the way it was.....

But to tell it this way, and to believe it this way... is to fall into UNREALITY....

AMERICAN WHITES, Baldwin says, have LOST THEIR GRIP ON REALITY....

They have created myths about Black Americans, and myths about their own history...and myths about the world....

WHAT BALDWIN WANTS FOR THE SCHOOLS -- for children's vantage points to be expanded so that they will SEE THE REAL WORLD....
